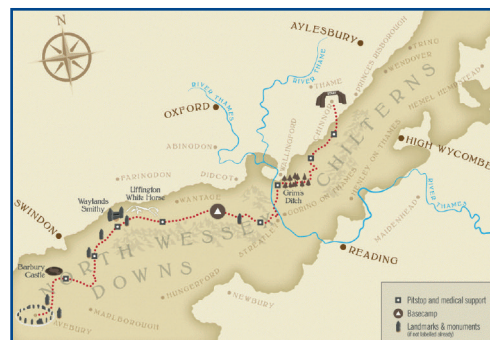
Thank you for your support in helping us to raise £1961

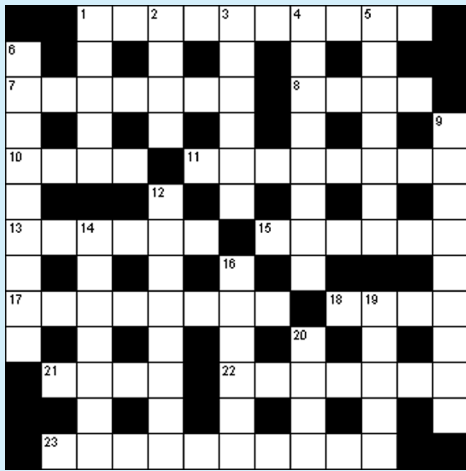
The ear continues to hear sounds, even while you sleep.

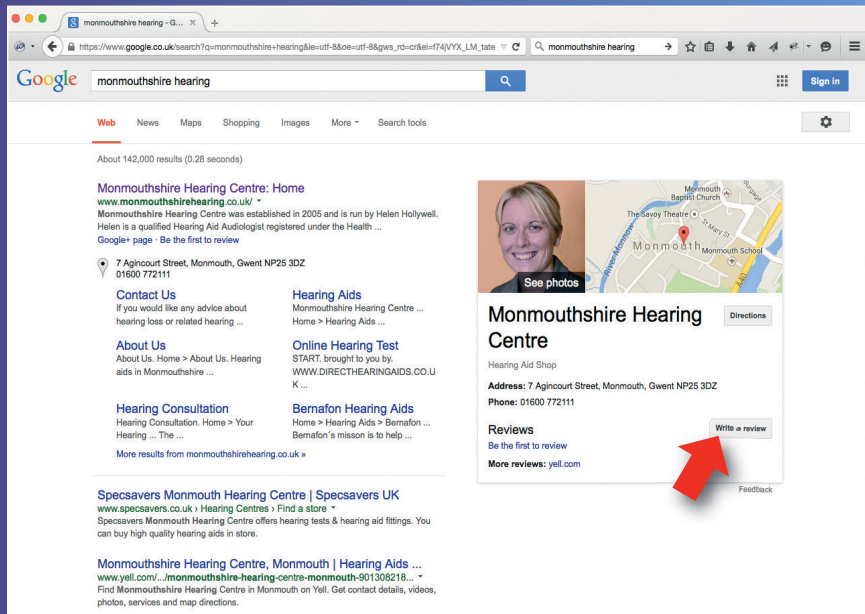
